

All vehicles will **access the Show Ground via the Addington Equestrian main entrance MK18 2JR.**

Thursday 30 July Arrival from 2.00pm, entrance gate closes at 11.00pm

Wednesday 5 August Arrival from 2.00pm, entrance gate closes at 11.00pm

Competition Days Entrance gate opens 6.45am

Horses requiring stabling must arrive on the showground before 7.00pm

Should any Competitor be delayed, they must contact the **Stable Manager** on **07487 423564.**

Stable Manager's Office is open daily from 7.00am – 7.30pm

Competitor Vehicle Passes:

Entry to the show ground is free. Competitors do not need vehicle passes and no passes will be sent to Competitors.

All vehicles will be parked in designated hardstanding or grass parking areas.

Show Ground Stabling:

There will be Temporary Barn Stables (3m x 3m), plus 75 Permanent Barn Stables (3.5m x 3.5m) at £30 extra as per the table below. The nearest parking for Permanent Stables will be on Hardstanding.

Stables must be booked on-line via My Riding Life when entries are made. If you wish to increase the number of nights a horse is stabled once the initial stable booking is made, please contact the Show Secretary on 07790 309424 to amend your booking. Lighting is not provided in the stables. Stables are for one horse / pony and may not be transferred to any other horses / ponies.

Should permanent stables not be full at the Close of Entries the remaining stables will be balloted.

Please bring your own feed and water buckets, hay nets, feed and mucking out equipment.

Natural Flake Shavings may be purchased on-site from the Stable Managers Office at £11.00 per bale and small bale haylage at £10.00 per bale between 8.00am and 7.00pm and not for purchase in advance.

Straw is not permitted. Any damage caused to stables will be charged to the hirer.

Hay or horse feed is not available to purchase on-site. Horseboxes / trailers may be parked some distance from the stables and wheelbarrows are recommended.

Stable Deposit:

All Competitors will pay a **£20 per stable cash deposit** upon arrival at the Stable Managers Office prior to being allocated stables. This deposit is fully refundable prior to departure and upon confirmation that the Competitors stable has been emptied of bedding and left tidy.

Electric Lorry Hook Up:

Electric hook ups for horseboxes in the hardstanding and grass parking areas are available at the following costs:

There is no hook up available between the two periods or after 8pm 8 August.

Competitors must have a 16amp (blue socket) extension cable to connect to the socket supplied by the Organiser. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all their cables and electrical equipment complies with current electrical regulations. Competitors must ensure that all electrical items in their horseboxes have a current PAT Certificate.

Whilst the Organiser will endeavour to supply the hook up booked; the Organiser does not guarantee a constant supply throughout the Show, nor to accept any responsibility for losses and / or discomfort occurring as a result of a break in the supply provided. Electrical connection must be booked on-line by Wednesday 15 July and is on a limited basis. No refunds can be made on cancelled hook up bookings.

No electrical hook up may be sub-let and may only be used by the Competitor who has made the purchase for the period that the Competitor is staying in the Show Ground.

Vaccination Record:

All horses and ponies at the Show must have a current and valid vaccination record against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of passports and **any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to stay at the Championships**. We will be following any British Showjumping updates regarding checking of passports.

All horses must have been fully vaccinated within the past twelve months before arriving at the event. Horses recently vaccinated must have six clear days after the vaccination before arriving at the Championships.

Drawn Order for Competitions:

Show Jumping – all classes are drawn orders, which will be available from 4.00pm the day prior to the competition by visiting www.trailblazerschampionships.com or the drawn orders will be available on the on-site Scoreboard.

Combined Training Championships – times for the dressage phase will be available from 4.00pm on Saturday 25 July at www.trailblazerschampionships.com. Competitors will jump in the same order in which they did their dressage test on each day.

Dressage – times for Thursday 6 August and Friday 7 August will be available from 4.00pm on Thursday 30 July by visiting www.trailblazerschampionships.com. Times for Saturday 8 August will be available from 8.00pm on Friday 7 August by visiting www.trailblazerschampionships.com.

Declaring:

Upon arrival, Competitors must declare in the Secretary's Office.

Medical Fee:

A fee of £16 per period (Period 1: 31 July – 3 August, Period 2: 6 – 8 August) will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.

Prize Giving:

Show Jumping – prize givings will take place at the end of each class.
Top 10 competitors in each class are required for the mounted prize giving.

Combined Training – prize givings will take place after the jumping phase.
Top 10 competitors in each class are required for the mounted prize giving.

Dressage – prize givings will take place in the Spillers Indoor Arena. Prize giving times will be available in the Secretary's Office.

Top 10 competitors in each class are required for the mounted prize giving.

Please see Rule 18 regarding prize givings.

Prize Money:

1st £30, 2nd £20, 3rd £10, 4th £5, 5th £5.

Awarded in all Combined Training, Dressage & Show Jumping Championship Competitions. This excludes dressage and show jumping warm up competitions. **All prize money must be collected before departure.**

Perpetual Trophies:

Perpetual Trophies will be retained by the organiser. Winners of classes where perpetual trophies are in place will have opportunities to have their photo taken with the trophy whilst on site.

Height Certificate for Show Jumping or Combined Training:

Horses suspected of being under 149cms competing in a Show Jumping Senior Championship or Combined Training Horse Championship may be asked for a life height certificate, unless declared as horse per BS rule 45. Ponies suspected of being over 148cms competing in a Show Jumping Junior Championship or Combined Training Pony Championship may be asked for a life height certificate. Failure to be able to prove a horse's or pony's height may result in elimination from the competition.

Breakfast will be available from 7.30am on each day of competition.

All warm-up show jumping competitions will take place in either the **SEIB Manor Arena** or **SEIB Baloubet Arena**. Each competition arena has a dedicated all-weather warm-up arena.

See the Show Jumping Timetable to view the order of competition.

All warm-up show jumping competitions are open to combinations that have entered the Trailblazers Cavaletti Saddles Show Jumping Finals 2026 or Trailblazers Atelier Equine Combined Training Finals 2026. Seniors on ponies may compete in Senior warm up Competitions.

There is no restriction on the number of warm-up competitions a competitor may enter, nor the height of competition that may be entered.

Competitors do not have to enter warm-up competitions to compete in Trailblazers Championship Finals. Warm-up competitions are purely optional.

The first rider will jump a 60cm high course, once the front hooves land over the last fence the second rider will start the 80cm high course. The clock will begin as the first competitor goes through the start and stop when the second competitor goes through the finish.

Pairs may be any combination of juniors and / or seniors who are competing in other competitions at the Trailblazers Championship Finals. Each competitor will jump approx. 7 individual fences (no doubles).

Entries may be limited and close before the 15 July.

Competition Arenas

All show jumping championships will take place in either the **SEIB Manor Arena** or **SEIB Baloubet Arena**. Each competition arena has a dedicated all-weather warm up arena.

Warm-Up Arenas

There is an all-weather warm-up arena for each competition arena.

Timetable

Please see the Show Jumping Timetable to view the order of competition. The Show Organizers reserve the right to amend start times, competition table and the arena in which any competition is held.

Drawn Order

All classes are in drawn order and start lists will be available on the onsite Scoreboard or on website www.trailblazerschampionships.com from 4pm the day prior to each competition. It is the competitor's responsibility to compete in the correct order; failure to do so may result in elimination.

Height of Fences

The height of fences is listed with the competition details for each Championship. If a competition is run under table T2 then the heights listed are for the first round and may be increased for the jump off.

Entry Fee

Entry fee £64 per Championship, includes entry for both Round 1 & Round 2.

Prize Money

1st £30, 2nd £20, 3rd £10, 4th £5, 5th £5, awarded in all Show Jumping competitions on 1 August – 3 August.

Rosettes

Cavaletti Saddles rosettes to 10th place in all show jumping competitions.

Show Jumping Championship Points System

Each Championship consists of two show jumping competitions; points will be awarded in each competition. Competitors in Round 2 will jump in reverse order of placing from Round 1.

First Competition Points

25 points are awarded for 1st place, 24 points for 2nd place, 23 points for 3rd place and so on down to 1 point for 25th place. Points are not awarded should a competitor be eliminated.

Second Competition Points

35 points are awarded for 1st place, 34 points for 2nd place, 33 points for 3rd place and so on down to 10 points for 25th place. Points are not awarded below 25th place and are not awarded should a competitor be eliminated.

The Champion will be the competitor with the greatest number of points after the two competitions. In the event of equality of points the competitor with the higher placing in Round 2 will be deemed the Champion. The competitor with the second highest points when applying the same system will be deemed the Reserve Champion.

Championship Prize Giving

Once the mounted prize giving for Round 2 has taken place and prior to the lap of honour, the Champion and Reserve Champion will be called forward for their prize giving. This will be followed by the lap of honour.

Failure to be able to prove a horse's or pony's height may result in elimination from the competition.

Combined Training Championship System

The results from the two Rounds will be combined to decide the overall Champion and Reserve Champion for each Championship.

In the event of a competitor being eliminated in the jumping phase, their dressage score will be halved to provide a jumping score for the purposes of determining an overall score after the two competitions.

Once the mounted prize giving for Round B has taken place in the SEIB Arena 1 and prior to the lap of honour, the Champion and Reserve Champion will be called forward for their prize giving. This will be followed by the lap of honour.

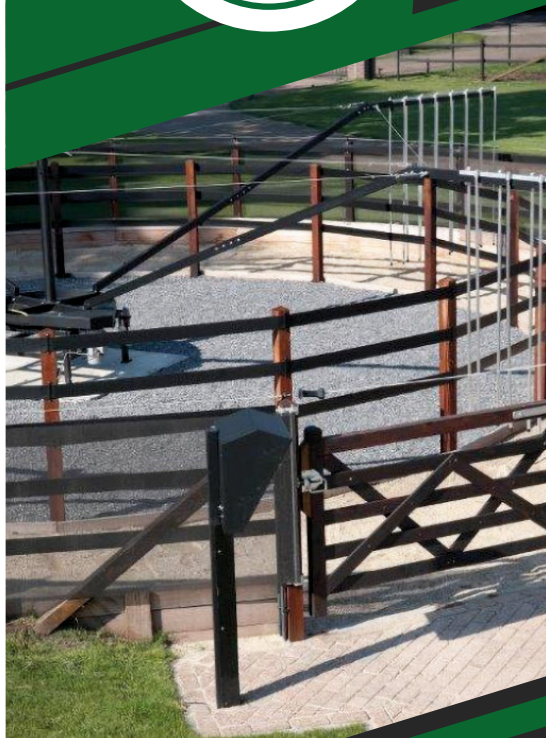

By entering the Show you confirm that you have read, understood, accept and agree to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Show and the Trailblazers Rules. In particular you acknowledge that the Organiser shall not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, injury, illness or damage to (whether or not foreseeable and howsoever caused), or any theft from, any Competitor, any horse or other animal, any vehicle, or any other property whatsoever in the Show Ground, providing that nothing shall exclude or limit the Organiser's liability for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence or that of its employees or agents.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read these General Rules and Regulations carefully. By entering, attending, or being in any way involved in any aspect of the Show, you indicate that you accept and agree to comply with these General Rules and Regulations.

1. **DEFINITIONS** – In these General Rules and Regulations the term “**Competitor**” refers to every Entrant and Associated Person. The term “**Entrant**” refers to all exhibitors and competitors entering the Show. The term “**Associated Person**” refers to all owners, riders, handlers, drivers, grooms, and parents / guardians of competitors under the age of 16 associates and / or supporters of Entrants. The term “**Show**” refers to the event known as the SEIB Trailblazers Championships held at Addington Equestrian, Buckinghamshire, MK18 2JR (the “**Show Ground**”). The term “**Organiser**” refers to Show Direct Ltd incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 04558504 and all its employees, officers, representatives, volunteers and show officials. The term “**Show Secretary**” refers to Sara Green or such other person as may be appointed to perform such role.

2. **RESPONSIBILITY** – The Organiser shall not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, injury, illness or damage to (whether or not foreseeable and howsoever caused), or any theft from, any Competitor, any horse or other animal, any vehicle, or any other property whatsoever in the Show Ground, provided that nothing shall exclude or limit the Organiser's liability for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence or that of its employees or agents.

Any items brought into the Show Ground or left in vehicles or tack lockers (whether locked or not) are at the Competitor's own risk. Competitors shall take such steps as are necessary to secure their property whilst in the Show Ground.

Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their horses are in good health and each Competitor shall take all necessary steps to prevent the contracting or spread of any disease or illness at the Show.

Competitors will be responsible for reimbursing the Organiser for all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including but not limited to any direct, indirect or resulting losses, loss of profit, loss of reputation and all interest, penalties and legal costs and all other reasonable professional costs and expenses) suffered or incurred by the Organiser arising out of or in connection with any breach of these Rules and Regulations by the Competitor or anyone under the control of the Competitor.

All Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult and may not be left at the Show unaccompanied.

Each Entrant will be considered responsible in all respects for the acts and/or failures to act of their Associated Persons. The Entrant shall be responsible for the consequences of any infringement by its Associated Persons of these Rules and Regulations.

Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regards to health and safety.

Upon any entry to any competition at the Show each Competitor acknowledges that he / she is taking part in a risk sport and represents that he / she is a competent rider at the level of competition in which he / she has entered.

Competitors who suffer a fall or any other injury whilst in the Show Ground must report the fall / injury to the Show Secretary.

Competitors shall comply with all Trailblazers Rules, which are available to view on www.trailblazerschampionships.com and any reasonable instructions given to them by the Organisers.

3. **INSURANCE** – Competitors are personally responsible for damage to: any buildings, land, equipment, or other property in the Show Ground; or to any third persons caused by the Competitor, their employees, their agents, or their horses / ponies. It is strongly advised that Competitors have in force third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in and attendance at the Show.

4. **CLOSE OF ENTRIES** - Entries will close on **Wednesday 15 JULY 2026** - **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED** Entries open on 17 June 2026 and will only be accepted online via My Riding Life by visiting www.trailblazerschampionships.com and clicking on the 'Enter the Championships' button

SUPPORT: If you experience any difficulties making an entry or require support, please text the MRL Team on 07798 626075. If you have any queries or wish to make any changes to an existing entry, please contact the Show Secretary on 07790 309424 or entries@showdirect.co.uk

Should space be available late entries may be accepted by contacting the Show Secretary. An additional fee of £4.00 per entry will be charged per entry.

5. **ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS** - It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure they have completed their entries in full, completing all fields where prompted and ensuring the correct payment has been made at the point of entry. Please note: There is a two night minimum stay for all stabled horses. Please ensure you select your two nights (or more) when booking

online. One night stabling is not available, and we reserve the right to select your second night on your behalf and charge the remaining balance to your credit or debit card as used to pay online. Therefore, please ensure you check your entry before completing your on-line payment.

6. **BALLOTING DRESSAGE ENTRIES** – In the unlikely event that dressage entries for the Show or an individual dressage championship at the Show become oversubscribed, then the Show Organiser reserves the right to ballot entries according to the date of entry. Any Competitors balloted out will be provided with a full refund less fees. Entries will be balloted after close of entries on 15 July and before release of times on Thursday 30 July.
7. **ADDITIONAL FEES** – The Organiser reserves the right to charge an additional fee to Competitors should extraordinary circumstances arise which require procedures to be implemented that would not normally be anticipated or expected, but were considered by the Organiser to be in the best interests for the wellbeing of either Competitors, horses and animals, general public and / or the successful running of the Championships.
8. **REMOVAL FROM THE SHOW** – The Organiser retains at its absolute discretion the right to decline entry or exclude or remove any person or animal from the Show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable to the Competitor for any compensation.
9. **QUALIFICATION** – Only qualified partnerships (horse / pony and rider) from Trailblazers Dressage Second Round Qualifiers or the Direct Show Jumping, and Combined Training Qualifiers are eligible to compete at the SEIB Trailblazers Championships Finals. In the event of a partnership (horse / pony and rider) ceasing, then the qualification will cease.
10. **COMPETITIONS** – The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions or the Show, as they deem appropriate.
11. **FIRST AID** – A fee of £16 per Competitor per period (30 July – 3 August or 5 – 8 August) will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.
12. **RE-PRESENTED PAYMENT** – Any payment that has to be re-presented to the bank for whatever reason will be subject to a £20.00 administration fee each time it is represented.
13. **VAT RECEIPTS** – All entries, medical, stable and hook-up fees include VAT.
14. **REFUND OF ENTRY, MEDICAL, STABLE AND HOOK UP FEES** – A refund of 75% of the entry, medical, hook up and / or stable fee will be made to Competitors who withdraw in writing prior to the Close of Entry on 15 July 2026. After 15 July any stable and / or hook up fee will be non-refundable. A refund of 50% of the entry and / or medical fee will be made until 10.00am on Thursday 23 July 2026, after which any entry and medical fee will be non-refundable.
15. **COMPETITION WARM-UP ARENA** – Designated competition warm-up arenas will be available for exercise from 3.30pm on Thursday 30 July and Wednesday 5 August until 7.00pm, after which it is available one hour prior to the start of competition each show day until 15 minutes after the conclusion of competition each day.

All warming up must be done in the designated warm up arenas provided by the Organiser. Competitors found abusing the show ground may be asked to leave the Show.

Horses not competing at the Show may not exercise in the Competition Warm-Up Arena.
16. **HAND GRAZING** – Hand grazing is available adjacent to the grass horse box parking area. Care should be taken when grazing horses. The welfare of the horse is the responsibility of the competitor.
17. **DRESS** – Hard hats, which comply with current safety requirements, must be worn at all times when mounted. Competitors must be correctly dressed when walking the course.
18. **PRIZE GIVING** – The Organisers reserve the right to withhold prizes if Competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving. Competitors must be mounted and must be dressed for the prize giving in the manner in which they competed. All prize money must be collected before departure.
19. **PERPETUAL TROPHIES** – Perpetual Trophies will be retained by the organiser. Winners of classes where perpetual trophies are in place will have opportunities to have their photo taken with the trophy whilst on site.
20. **ALL VEHICLES** – The Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access (even if locked and unattended) and the Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.
21. **LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS (LPG)** – Bottled gas may be used in conjunction with fitted living accommodation within horseboxes sited in the lorry park; however, it is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all gas bottles are fitted correctly and that all appliances are fitted to the gas bottle through approved pipework.
22. **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS** – All vehicles must be equipped with an appropriate fire extinguisher conforming to Local Authority Regulations.
23. **VEHICLES REQUIRING TOWING** – Should any vehicle become stuck on soft ground while in the Show Ground the Competitor must contact an official immediately who will arrange for the vehicle to be towed onto hard standing. The Organiser reserves the right to charge the Competitor if, in the opinion of the Organiser, excess damage is done to the ground by the Competitor prior to requesting the towing service or by not waiting for the towing service to arrive. The Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage howsoever caused while the Organiser's agents are in the process of towing any vehicle.
24. **VEHICLE ACCESS AND PASSES** – There is no charge for Competitor vehicles to park in the Show Ground. Competitors will not need vehicle passes and no passes will be sent to Competitors. All vehicles will be parked in designated parking areas and Competitors are required to follow all directions given by the official parking staff.

25. **SMOKING** – Is not permitted within any building or marquee on the Show Ground or within the stable area.
26. **MOTORBIKES, SCOOTERS, BICYCLES AND QUAD BIKES** – Except for authorised official vehicles used by the Organiser, motorbikes, scooters, bicycles or quad bikes are not permitted at the Show. Disability vehicles are permitted.
27. **DOGS** –Dogs are permitted in the Show Ground, but not permitted within the indoor buildings. All dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. If, in the opinion of the Organiser, any person fails to control their dog/s they may be asked to leave the Show Ground.
28. **OBJECTIONS** – Objections should be made in writing in accordance to Point 6 in the Trailblazers General Rules, which document is available on the Trailblazers website. A £80 deposit in cash will be required per objection.
29. **OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND FILM FOOTAGE** – It is understood and agreed by Competitors that any photographs and/or film footage taken at the Show by any official photographer may be used by the Organiser for security and/or promotional purposes without payment.
30. **VETERINARY SURGEON** – The services of a vet are only available “On Call”. Please contact the Stable Manager on **07487 423564**. Competitors are responsible for any costs incurred in making such call outs.
31. **SHOW GROUND ACCESS** – Horses may arrive on the Show Ground from 2.00pm on Thursday 30 July and from 2.00pm Wednesday 5 August and the Show Ground entrance will be closed at 11.00pm. Access to the Show Ground will be from 6.45am – 11.00pm on Show days. Outside of these times the entrance will be opened for emergency access only. **Horses requiring stabling must arrive on the showground before 7.00pm**. Should any Competitor be delayed, they **must** contact the **Stable Manager** on **07487 423564**. **The Stable Managers Office will close at 7.30pm each night**.

Only horseboxes / trailers bringing horses and / or ponies intending to compete at the Show will be admitted to the Show Ground.

32. **COMPETITOR HORSEBOXES, CARAVANS & TENTS** – While a Competitor has a horse/s stabled on site at night at the Show the Competitor may stay overnight on the Show Ground in a horsebox, caravan or tent.

STABLING – There will be Temporary Barn Stables (3m x 3m), plus 75 Permanent Barn Stables (3.5m x 3.5m) at £30 extra as per the table below. The nearest parking for Permanent Stables will be on Hardstanding..

Stables must be booked on-line via My Riding Life when entries are made. If you wish to increase the number of nights a horse is stabled once the initial stable booking is made, please contact the Show Secretary on 07790 309424 to amend your booking. Lighting is not provided in the stables. Stables are for one horse / pony and may not be transferred to any other horses / ponies. All stables must be vacated by 9am 9 August.

To book for a stable for 6 -10 nights, please contact the Show Secretary on 07790 309424 or entries@showdirect.co.uk as these cannot be booked online.

Should permanent stables not be full at the Close of Entries the remaining stables will be balloted.

Please bring your own feed and water buckets, hay nets, feed and mucking out equipment.

All Competitors will **pay a £20 per stable cash deposit upon arrival at the Stable Managers Office** prior to being allocated stables. This deposit is fully refundable prior to departure and upon confirmation that the Competitors stable has been emptied of bedding and left tidy. If the stable is not emptied of bedding and left tidy the deposit will not be refunded.

Any damage caused to stables will be charged to the hirer. No stables may be sub-let, and they are only for use by the Competitor who has made the purchase for the period that the Competitor is staying in the Show Ground.

Hay, haylage or horse feed is not available to purchase on-site.

It is understood by Competitors that horseboxes / trailers may be parked some distance from the stables.

Anyone stabling between 8pm 3 August and 2pm 5 August or after 8pm 8 August understands and agrees that venue is being altered or dismantled and they do so at their own risk. The main gate will not be manned during this time.

33. **HORSES STABLED ON VEHICLES** – Horses may not be stabled in horseboxes / trailers. A Competitor deemed by the Organiser to be stabling their horse / pony in such a way will be asked to leave the Show Ground.
34. **UNAUTHORISED USE OF STABLES** – Any Competitor who enters or makes use of any stable that has not been officially reserved for their use will be liable to a fine of £180 per stable.
35. **STABLE BEDDING** – Although bedding may be in the stable allocated to the Competitor from previous occupants, no bedding whatsoever is provided with the hire of the stable. Natural Flake Shavings may be purchased from the Stable Managers Office at £11.00 per bale between 10.00am and 7.00pm. Straw is not permitted in stables.
36. **STORAGE OF BEDDING & FODDER** – No hay, fodder or any flammable materials may be stored by the Competitor next to or underneath their horsebox and should be stored within their vehicles. Should the Competitor fail to comply with this requirement they may be asked to leave the Show Ground.

37. **HAYLAGE** – Small bale haylage is available to purchase from the Stable Managers Office at £10.00 per bale between 10.00am and 7.00pm.
38. **VACCINATION CERTIFICATE** – All horses and ponies at the Show must have a current and valid vaccination record against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of passports and **any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to stay at the Championships**. We will be following any British Showjumping updates regarding checking of passports.
- All horses must have been fully vaccinated within the past twelve months before arriving at the event. Horses recently vaccinated must have six clear days after the vaccination before arriving at the Championships.
39. **HOOK UPS** – A limited number of 16amp electrical hook ups are available for horseboxes at the following cost:

- There is not hook up available between the two periods or after 8pm 8 August.
- No electrical hook up may be sub-let and they are only for use by the Competitor who has made the purchase for the period that the Competitor is staying in the Show Ground.
- Competitors must have a 16amp (blue socket) extension cable to connect to the socket supplied by the Organiser. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all their cables and electrical equipment complies with current electrical regulations. Competitors must ensure that all electrical items in their horseboxes have a current PAT Certificate.
- Whilst the Organiser endeavours to supply the hook up booked the Organiser does not guarantee a constant supply throughout the Show, nor do we accept any responsibility for losses and / or discomfort occurring as a result of a break in the supply provided. Electrical connection must be booked on-line by Wednesday 15 July 2026 and is on a limited basis. No refunds can be made on any cancelled hook up bookings.
40. **GENERATORS** – Competitors may have generators in the horsebox parking areas providing they are moderately sized and do not reach a noise or emission level whereby, in the opinion of the Organiser, they become a nuisance. The Competitor is responsible for ensuring that any generator complies with all health and safety regulations and that all users adhere to the re-fuelling procedure set out in the Organiser's document: - P 04 'Re-fuelling vehicles and Equipment 121116' which is available on-site from the Stable Managers Office or in advance by request to the Organiser. All generators must be turned off between the hours of 11.00pm and 8.00am.
41. **HORSE WALK** – Designated walkways are available for competitors to access the competition arenas. Competitors on foot on the horse walks do so at their own risk. Horse walks are not open to the general public.
42. **STALLIONS** – No person shall allow a stallion for which he / she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury.
- Stallions must be identified whilst on the Show Ground. It is recommended that stallions should wear a stallion disc and a white ribbon in the tail. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that their stallion is clearly identified as such by other Competitors.
43. **REFRESHMENTS** – Available from 5.00pm Thursday 30 July for Show Jumping and combined Training, from Wednesday 5 August for Dressage and open from 7.30am on competition days.
44. **BARBEQUES** – No unofficial barbeques are permitted in the Show Ground.
45. **CASH POINT** – There is no cash point on the show ground.
46. **LOST PROPERTY** – All lost property during the show will be located at the Secretary's Office. Any inquiries regarding lost property following the conclusion of the Show should be made to Wendy at wendy@showdirect.co.uk.
47. **ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR** – Any act of anti-social behaviour, including excessive noise, will result in those responsible being required to leave the Show.
48. **OTHER TERMS** – If any court declares that any provision of these Rules and Regulations is invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent, the provision will, to that extent, be severed from the remaining provisions, which will continue to be valid to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- These Rules and Regulations are governed by English law. The Organiser and Competitor both agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
